

# TREASURER'S REPORT

The Club finished the season with a profit of \$772.63 in the cheque account leaving a closing balance of \$5621.13.

The Social Account has a closing balance of \$1089.54, Coaching Account \$89.20 and the Centenary Account \$2738.34.

The Social Committee raised \$11,800. This figure was achieved with Phil White's excellent work and not to mention a lot of this time in raising \$5,900 from the Supporter's Club and Lucky Tickets (including Bingo). Without his effort this season the Club would not be in the financial position it is in. The MAS Raffle netted \$2667.84.

The biggest expenses were S.A.B.L. \$7,185.75, Baseballs \$1212.20 Equipment \$756.50 and C.L.G. Assoc. Levy \$2000.00 and Membership \$2180.00. There are still 5 annual repayments of \$773.04 to be made for the backstop.

There is still a need for stronger support for the Club in the area of Associate or Non-Playing Memberships.

On closing I would like to thank Kerri Fletcher for running the Canteen, Steve Baker for selling chips etc in the bar and the many people who helped in the Kitchen.
